**Re: Ongoing Odour Issues at Langney Point Wastewater Treatment Plant**

I am writing again to raise concerns regarding the persistent strong odours emanating from the Wastewater Treatment Plant at Langney Point. Residents have informed me that this issue has been ongoing for over a decade, and I have recently been contacted by several residents who continue to be affected.

In your previous correspondence, you acknowledged issues with the on-site scrubber system and indicated that the refurbishment project *"could take several years to complete."* This extended timeline is deeply concerning for residents who have already endured years of disruption.

As a temporary measure, you mentioned the use of a "separate smaller odour management system that simply sprays a non-invasive, non-harmful perfume into the environment." I would appreciate further details on the effectiveness of this system and whether any additional measures are being considered to mitigate the odours in the short-term.

Furthermore, I would be grateful if you could clarify the expected timeline for the completion of the refurbishment project and what assurances can be given to residents that this matter will be resolved as soon as possible.

I look forward to your response and appreciate your time in addressing these concerns.
